INFORMATION ON CLINICAL RESEARCH TRIALS

A clinical trial is a research study conducted in people to evaluate a new investigational medical drug, or device. The purpose of clinical trials is to find new and improved methods of treating different diseases in the future.

A study may not benefit participants directly, but the information gathered may be of help to other individuals in the future with the same condition. Many study participants derive satisfaction knowing they may be a part of the effort to potentially reduce the suffering of other people in the future.

There are many reasons people take part in research studies. It gives individuals a chance to receive investigational study drug not available to the public. Studies are performed to test if the investigational study drug works and to see if it is safe.

Androgenetic Alopecia (AGA), also known as male pattern baldness, is the most common cause of hair loss and may affect up to 70% of men at some point in their lifetime.

If you have mild to moderate male-pattern baldness, and are dissatisfied with your overall hair appearance, the Vertex Hair Growth may be right for you.

During each study-related visit, the study doctor will evaluate male pattern baldness severity and record hair growth progression.

ABOUT THE STUDY

Participation in this research study will include 1 screening visit, and 6 study visits to the research center, over a period of approximately 36 weeks.

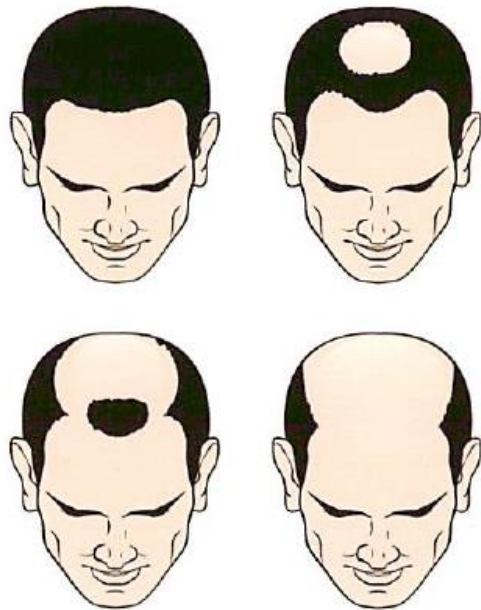
Study participants receive study-related labs and procedures at no cost, and compensation for time and travel is available.
